

## REGULATIONS FOR ACCREDITATION ASSIGNMENT

1. Accreditations are granted free of charge.
2. Accreditations are named and accompanied by an ID photo. They cannot be made available to third parties.
3. Accreditations may be requested by journalists and photographers from press, radio, television and online media outlets.
4. Accreditations are granted on the basis of accreditation applications submitted via a completed form to be downloaded from the website: [www.episkopat.pl](http://www.episkopat.pl). The completed, signed and scanned form should be returned by email to: [press\\_ulma@episkopat.pl](mailto:press_ulma@episkopat.pl).
5. The Accreditation Office reserves the right to reject an accreditation application.
6. The process of accepting accreditation applications will start on July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023 and will last until August 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023. **After this date applications cannot be submitted.**
7. The accreditation entitles the holder to participate in the media coverage of the ceremony of the Beatification of the Ulma Family on September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023, in Markowa.
8. Accreditation includes the right to use the Press Centre and to move around the special areas designated for journalists in Zone 0.
9. Accreditation does not entitle anyone to enter the VIP area or the altar area.
10. On the premises of the Press Centre, the accredited journalists have access to: press materials/texts, Internet connection, viewing of the ceremony (video and audio), professional connection for radio journalists, briefings before and after the ceremony, snacks and drinks.
11. While performing their professional tasks, the journalists must carry accreditation cards which should be visible to security staff.
